Beginning Genealogy Workshop on April 10

The Santa Maria Public Library invites you to a free Beginning Genealogy workshop at 11 a.m. on Wednesday, April 10, 2013, in Shepard Hall.

You never know what you will discover in genealogical research. It could be a long-lost sibling or family member, or it could be a family member who was a famous artist or inventor. If you want to learn the basics of genealogical research then this workshop is for you. The workshop is offered to those who would like to learn where to start their research and how to keep track of their data. The workshop will also include some basic genealogy websites and resources, and common mistakes to avoid in gathering genealogical information.

Ms. Cryor, the Head of Reference Services of the Santa Maria Public Library, will be conducting the workshop. Members of the Santa Maria Valley Genealogical Society will be on hand to answer genealogical questions.
