Nipomo Arts Commission to Exhibit at the Santa Maria Public Library

The Shepard Hall Gallery at the Santa Maria Public Library will be exhibiting more than one dozen Central Coast artists featured in the Nipomo Arts Commission exhibit, "Celebrating the Beauty of the Central Coast."

Many of the featured artists were participants and award winners in the third annual "Arts at the Adobe" event held last fall. The exhibit, which runs April 1 to April 26, 2013, includes various mediums such as watercolors, oils, acrylic, photography, and fabric art.

The opening reception will be held on Friday, April 5th from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. in Shepard Hall and refreshments will be served. There will be a gift basket raffle to help raise funds for the Nipomo Arts Commission Scholarship fund. The gift basket includes a \$350 getaway package from a generous donation made by the Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians Foundation. This includes a one-night stay at the newly remodeled Chumash Casino Resort Hotel and Spa, and dinner for two at their upscale restaurant, *Willows*. Raffle tickets are one for a dollar, six for \$5, 12 for \$10, 18 for \$15, and 25 for \$20.
